"Today the price of our Laundrite 4kg Laundry Powder, which is already phosphate free, became even lower. It has been reduced from \$4.29 to \$3.69; this new price shows it doesn't have to cost you the earth to reduce your impact on it," says Mr Kopp.

ALDI's core range laundry detergents already include a number of phosphate free products, including:

- Almat Laundry Powder Concentrate (3kg) retails for \$6.49
- Laundrite Laundry Liquid (2L) retails for \$1.49

Jon Dee, Founder and Managing Director of Do Something!, is running the campaign to ban phosphates in Australia's laundry powder and liquids. He says the decision by ALDI is a major win for the environment and consumers.
